**Ordinance for Admission to M.Sc. (Semester System)  
in the Faculty of Science including M.A. in Mathematics and  
Statistics in the Universities of Bihar**

**1.0 Preamble**

The Post Graduate Degree, called 'Master of Science' in the Faculty of Science, shall be offered in the following Subjects: Botany, Chemistry, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Herbal Chemistry, Zoology, Environmental Science, Geography, Anthropology and Home Science, Biochemistry and Biotechnology & Bioinformatics. The 'Master of Science' course shall be abbreviated as M.Sc. Course. The courses will spread over a period of two years (Four Semesters) duration. Each academic session shall have First and Third semesters from July to December and Second and Fourth from January to June every year.

**2.0 Admission**

- 2.1 A candidate seeking admission to M.Sc. (Semester System) must be a graduate with Bachelor Honours Degree in the subject concerned.
- 2.2 In case of students do not having Honours Bachelor Degree, their relative merit vis-a-vis Honours candidate will be judged as having 10% less than the Honours candidate.
- 2.3 In such subjects where candidate with Honours/Pass are not available, students with allied subjects may be treated at par as having Honours Degree in the subjects. The academic council of the University will decide the allied subjects on the recommendation of equivalence committee of the University.
- 2.4 In case the sanctioned seats remain vacant in any category, they shall be filled by candidates next in the merit list.
- 2.5 (a) The reservation of seats for the courses shall be as per reservation rules of the Government of Bihar.  
(b) A maximum of two seats each over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in Sports & Fine Arts. Under this category only those applicants will be considered who have represented their University/State at the State/National Level events.  
(c) A maximum of two seats in each subject shall be reserved for physically handicapped and sons/daughters of unmilitary personals. This reservation shall be over and above the sanctioned seats.  
(d) Maximum of Two seats over and above the normal strength shall be reserved for applicants having NCC-C Certificate or NSS

- (e) No candidate shall be entitled to two weightages.
- 2.6 The total number of seats for the M.Sc. (Semester System) in each subject shall be decided by the concerned University in accordance with the guideline received from the State Government from time to time.
- 2.7 No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time.
- 2.8 (a) The admitted students can appear in the University examination only when they are registered with their respective Universities.
- (b) No such applicant shall be admitted who, in the opinion of the Head of the Department and endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor, should not be admitted in the best interest of the respective University.
- (c) Any student admitted to M.Sc. (Semester System), if it is found at any letter point of time that any document/documents or submission made by him in support of his/her admission is/are forced are false, his admissions shall stand cancelled. The concerned students shall be solely responsible for the cancellation of the admission or other punitive action.
- 2.9 No candidate shall be allowed to register as a student in any other course during the same academic sessions of his/her study of M.S. in the faculty of Science.
- 2.10 2% seats of the sanctioned stands in any subjects may be filled with NRI/Foreign students. These seats will be treated as over and above the normal sanctioned strength. Applications of NRI under this category students recommended by M.E.A. (Ministry of External Affairs) and such students with a bonafide proof of NRI status may apply for admission. The fee and another charges shall be deposited in appropriate foreign currency.
- 2.11 Admission of students to the Post-graduate Courses in Statistics and Mathematics in the Faculty of Social Sciences shall be made in order of merit on the basis of marks obtained by applicants in Statistics and Mathematics at the Bachelor examinations subject to the condition and restrictions prescribed hereunder:-
  - (a) Applicants securing Honours in Statistic/Mathematics.
  - (b) Applicants who have studied Statistics/Mathematics for three consecutive years at the Undergraduate level.
- 2.12 (a) No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time or who being selected for admission does not get himself/herself admitted with the specified time except where the delay has been condoned in a special case.

Ordinance for Admission to M.A. (Semester System)  
in the Faculty of Humanities in the Universities of Bihar

1.0 Preamble

The Post Graduate Degree "Master of Arts" in Faculty of Humanities shall be offered by the Universities of Bihar in the following subjects :

English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Arabic, Persian, Urdu, Bengali, Maithili, Philosophy, Pali, Nepali, Bhojpuri, Magahi, Angika, Gandhian Thought, Islamic Studies and Buddhist Studies.

The course shall be of Four Semesters spread over two years duration. The "Master of Arts" course shall be abbreviated as M.A.

2.0 Admission

2.1 A candidate seeking admission to M.A. (Semester System) must be a graduate with Bachelor Honours Degree in the subject concerned.

2.2 In case of students not having Honours Bachelor Degree, their relative merit vis-a-vis Honours degree will be judged as having 10% less marks than the applicants having Honours degree.

2.3 In such subjects where candidate with Honours/Pass degree are not available, students having degree in allied subjects may be treated at par as having Honours Degree in the subject. The academic council of the University on the recommendation of its equivalence committee shall decide the allied subject/subjects.


2.4 Admission to M.A. Part-I (First Semester), shall be made in order of merit. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the applicant in the subject concerned at the bachelor examination.

In case the sanctioned seats remain vacant in any category, they shall be filled by candidates next in the merit list.

2.5 (a) The reservation of seats in each courses shall be as per reservation rules of the Government of Bihar.

(b) A maximum of two seats in each subject over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in Sports & Fine Arts. Under this category only those applicants shall be considered who have represented their University/State in different disciplines at state/national level events.

(c) A maximum of two seats each shall be reserved for physically handicapped and sons/daughters of military personnel. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength for the subject.

- (d) Over and above the normal sanctioned strength, Two seats shall be reserved for NCC-C Certificate holder/NSS participant representing University/State.
- (e) No student shall be provided two weightages for the purpose of admission.
- 2.6 The total number of seats in each subject in the faculty of Humanities shall be decided by the concerned University in accordance with the guideline received from the State Government from time to time.
- 2.7 No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time.
- 2.8 (a) The admitted students will have to register themselves with their respective university of study to be able to appear in the University examination.
- (b) No such applicant shall be admitted who, in the opinion of the Head of the Department and endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor, should not be admitted in the best interest of the respective University.
- (c) During the tenure of the course, if it is found that any document/documents or submission made by a student in support of his/her admission to M.A. (Humanities) is/are forged or fake, his/her admissions shall automatically stand cancelled. The concerned student shall be solely responsible for the cancellation of his/her admission and other punitive action/actions.
- 2.9 No candidate shall be allowed to register for any other course in the university during the same academic sessions of his/her study of M.A. Humanities subjects..
- 2.10 2% seats of the sanctioned strength in any subjects may be filled with NRI/Foreign students. These seats will be treated as over and above the normal sanctioned strength. Applications of NRI under this category such students recommended by M.E.A. (Ministry of External Affairs) and admission. The fee and another charges shall be deposited in appropriate foreign currency.

3.0 The Fee Structure for the M.A. Shall be as follows :

Ordinance for Admission to M.A. (Semester System)  
in the Faculty of Social Sciences in the Universities of Bihar

1.0 Preamble

The Post Graduate Degree "Master of Arts" in Faculty of Humanities shall be offered by the Universities of Bihar in the following subjects:

Ancient Indian History and Archaeology, Economics, Geography, History, Home Science, Personnel Management & Industrial Relations (PMIR), Political Science, Psychology and Sociology, Tourism, Education, Rural Studies, Rural Economics, Anthropology, Social Work, Public Administration, Labour and Social Welfare and Home Science.


The course shall be of two-years (Four Semester) duration. The "Master of Arts" course shall be abbreviated as M.A.

2.0 Admission

- 2.1 A candidate seeking admission to M.A. (Semester System) must be a graduate with Bachelor Honours Degree in the subject concerned.
- 2.2 In case of students do not having Honours Bachelor Degree, their relative merit vis-a-vis Honours candidate will be judged as having 10% less than the Honours candidate.
- 2.3 In such subjects where candidate with Honours/Pass are not available, students with allied subjects may be treated at par as having Honours Degree in the subjects. The academic council of the University will decide the allied subjects on the recommendation of equivalence committee of the University.
- 2.4 Admission to M.A. Part-I (First Semester), excluding professional courses like PMIR, Rural Studies, Women Studies etc., shall be made in order of merit on basis of marks obtained by the applicant in the subject concerned at the bachelor examination.

In case the sanctioned seats remain vacant in any category, they shall be filled by candidates next in the merit list.

- 2.5 (a) The reservation of seats for the courses shall be as per reservation rules of the Government of Bihar.
- (b) A maximum of two seats each over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in Sports & Fine Arts. Under this category only those applicants will be considered who have represented their University/State.
- (c) A maximum of Two seats each for physically handicapped and sons and daughters of military personnels, this reservation will also be over and above normal sanctioned strength.

Ordinance for Admission to M.Com. (Semester System)  
in the Faculty of Commerce in the Universities of Bihar

1.0 Preamble

The Post Graduate Degree "Master of Commerce" in Faculty of Commerce shall be offered by the Universities of Bihar.

1.1 The M.Com. course shall be of Four Semesters spread over two years duration. The "Master of Commerce" course shall be abbreviated as M.Com.

2.0 Admission

2.1 A candidate seeking admission to M.Com. (Semester System) must be a graduate with Bachelor of Commerce (B. Com.) Honours Degree or in allied subjects like BBA or BBM.

2.2 In case of students not having Honours Bachelor Degree, their relative merit vis-a-vis Honours degree will be judged as having 10% less marks than the applicants having Honours degree.

2.3 In such subjects where candidate with Honours/Pass degree are not available, students having degree in allied subjects may be treated at par as having Honours Degree in the subject. The academic council of the University on the recommendation of its equivalence committee shall decide the allied subject/subjects.

2.4 Admission to M.A. Part-I (First Semester), shall be made in order of merit. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the applicant in the subject concerned at the bachelor examination.

In case the sanctioned seats remain vacant in any category, they shall be filled by candidates next in the merit list.

2.5 (a) The reservation of seats in each courses shall be as per reservation rules of the Government of Bihar.

(b) A maximum of two seats in each subject over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in Sports & Fine Arts. Under this category only those applicants shall be considered who have represented their University/State in different disciplines at state/national level events.

(c) A maximum of two seats each shall be reserved for physically handicapped and sons/daughters of military personnels. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength for the subject.

- (d) A maximum of Two seats over and above normal sanctioned strength be reserved for NCC-C Certificate holder/NPES volunteer participating National level events representing the University or State.
- (e) No candidate shall be entitled to two weightages.
- 2.6 The total number of seats for the M.A. (Semester System) in each subject shall be decided by the concerned University in accordance with the guideline received from the State Government from time to time.
- 2.7 No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time.
- 2.8 (a) The admitted students can appear in the University examination only when they are registered with their respective Universities.
- (b) No such applicant shall be admitted who, in the opinion of the Head of the Department and endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor, should not be admitted in the best interest of the respective University.
- (c) Any student admitted to M.A. (Semester System), if it is found at any later point of time that any document/documents or submission made by him in support of his/her admission is/are found to be false, his admissions shall stand cancelled. The concerned students shall be solely responsible for the cancellation of the admission or other punitive action.
- 2.9 No candidate shall be allowed to register as a student in any other course during the same academic sessions of his/her study of M.A. Social Science.
- 2.10 2% seats of the sanctioned stands in any subjects may be filled with NRI/Foreign students. These seats will be treated as over and above the normal sanctioned strength. Applications of NRI under this category such students recommended by M.E.A. (Ministry of External Affairs) and such students with a bonafide proof of NRI status may apply for admission. The fee and another charges shall be deposited in appropriate foreign currency.

3.0 Special Provisions :

- (a) Students who passed the Diploma examination in Public Administration or the Diploma Examination in International Relations may be admitted in the M.A. Course in Political Science and Public Administration. Their relative merit vis-a-vis Honours Degree in a Political Science shall be as having 5% less marks than candidates with the Honours Degree.
- (b) Science graduates may also apply for admission to M.A. in Ancient Indian History and Archaeology. They have to compete in general merit

(e) No student shall be provided two weightages for the purpose of admission.

2.6 The total number of seats for M.Com. shall be decided by the concerned University in accordance with the guidelines received from the State Government from time to time.

2.7 No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time.

2.8 (a) The admitted students will have to register themselves with their respective university of study to be able to appear in the University examination.

(b) No such applicant shall be admitted who, in the opinion of the Head of the Department and endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor, should not be admitted in the best interest of the respective University.

Applications of NRI under this category such students recommended by M.E.A. (Ministry of External Affairs) and admission. The fee and another charges shall be deposited in appropriate foreign currency.
